thus seen to be an inclusive survey in keeping with the title. It is a useful book. Each chapter is followed by references for further reading and there is an adequate index.

Following the Prairie Frontier. By SETH K. HUMPHREY. (Minneapolis: The University of Minnesota Press, 1931. Pp. 265. \$2.50.)

This anecdotal record, the author says, begins "with my father's pioneering in Minnesota Territory from 1855 on and continuing with my own experiences after 1870. The narrative has to do with the Middle Northwest during its first forty years as white man's country."
