since 1917 is unusually modest. A search has revealed the appearance of his name but once in the volume, on page 57.

The usual brief accounts are here of all the national parks covering the year 1925. The Director mentions the needs of Mount Rainier National Park on pages 37-38 and, on pages 109114, Major Owen A. Tomlinson, Superintendent, gives the year's record of the same park. He shows that the total travel into the park for the year was 161,796 .
