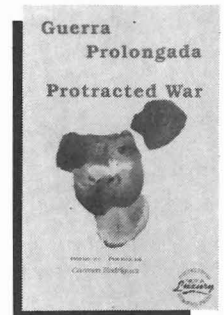
## NOT A LUXURY POETRY SERIES
