**Michael Biggins** is an affiliate professor of Slavic languages and literatures at the University of Washington in Seattle, where he teaches Slovene language (introductory to advanced), as well as courses on Slovene literature and Slovene-to-English literary translation. He has translated some twenty published book-length works of Slovene literature into English, including poetry by Tomaž Šalamun and Edvard Kocbek, as well as major prose works by authors Vladimir Bartol, Mate Dolenc, Florjan Lipuš, Drago Jančar, Lojze Kovačič, and Boris Pahor. In 2015 he became the first translator into English to be awarded the Janko Lavrin Diploma of the Society of Slovene Literary Translators, and in 2018 he was appointed Honorary Consul of Slovenia for Washington State. Besides Russian language and nineteenth-century literature, he taught courses on the cultural history of East Central Europe in which he treated various Slovene topics. He has written extensively on the work of Jernej Kopitar and his place in European cultural history. His translation (with Tatjana Jamnik) of Jure Detela's 1983 collection of poetry *Mah in srebro* (*Moss & Silver*) was published by Ugly Duckling Presse in 2018 and was a finalist for Best Translated Book of the Year.
